There was no official meeting held due to lack of quorum. The commission is currently down one member.

Commissioners McAuliffe, Mirovsky and Petrucci reviewed the 44 total surveys received as the result of the April 25th mailing to 300 businesses and the hand delivery of 46 follow-up surveys to non-responders. In a working session, the three members reviewed the written comments and discussed common themes. There were new complaints about infrastructure items, such as water and sewer and cell phone coverage, and complaints about the cost of fitting up a new business being far higher than other towns.

McAuliffe will summarize the responses into a report for the Board of Selectmen and for release to the press. He will also solicit more "Main Street" responses and from Local Developers in hopes of increasing the returns.

Without a quorum the commissioners could not vote on the Quassy tax incentive. A special meeting will be called in early July to review the application.
